Opening & Closing Dates

The ice plant will be activated on October 1st. Our plan is to have ice in place for League play to begin as early as Oct. 21st. We need all the help we can get to prepare the ice surface so please email or call the Club if you are able to assist in any way. The Club itself will be open for business as of Oct. 17th. Our tentative closing date this season is April 27th.

Membership Rates

We are still in the process of fine-tuning our membership types and rates to ensure that they are fair and competitive. In the meantime, we can share that most rates will be similar or even better than those for last year, and with more options for those who can only play half the season. We expect to release the final rates next week.

Curling Leagues
